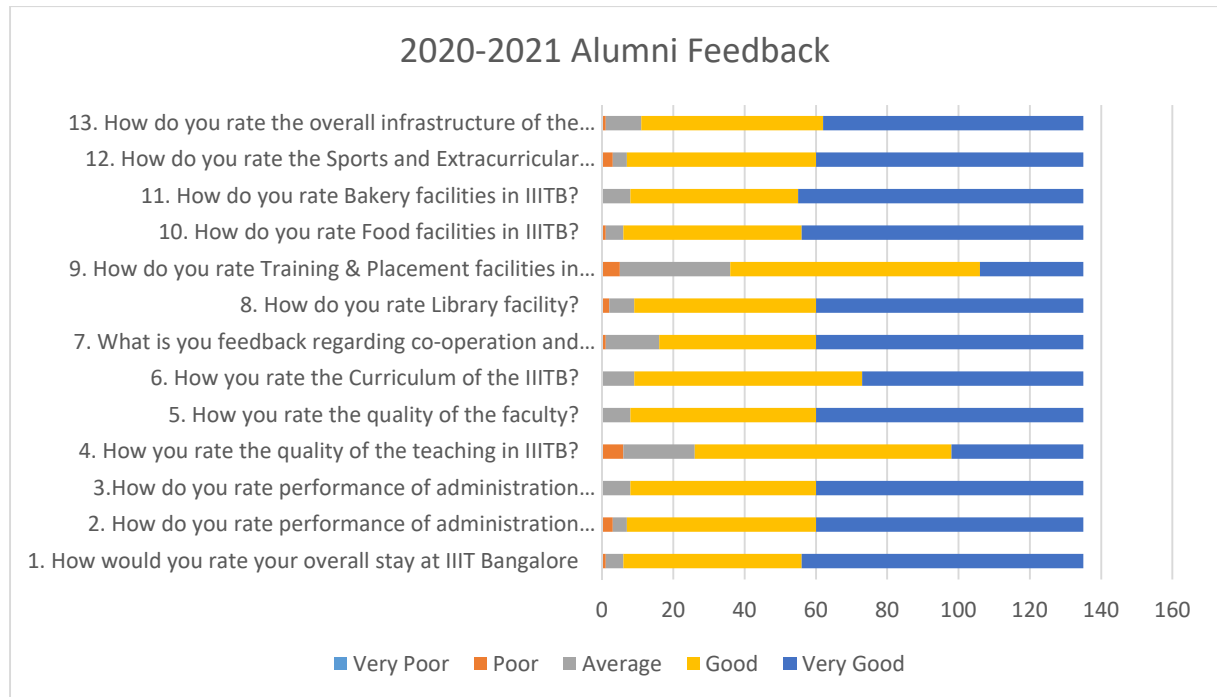

Introduction

IIIT Bangalore's top-most priority is the welfare and academic excellence of its students. In order to ensure that the administration is fully aware of the ground situation regarding the students, IIITB has designed a unique 360-degree approach to conducting analyzing all feedback received



Analysis

A majority of the students have given GOOD or VERY GOOD rating on most of the questions. Considering that this feedback pertains to remote learning experience forced by the COVID-19 pandemic, the feedback pertaining to the following areas needs to be improved:

-) Quality of teaching – access to online classes disrupted due to internet issues
-) Training & Placement – access to mentoring and additional training was limited (normally provided when students are in campus)

Action Recommended

1. Use tools for online teaching that also supports recording of classes so that students who have internet issues can view the recordings later
2. Allow students to unmute and speak to ask questions during online classes
3. Start special "VALUE ADDED COURSES" program that offers courses outside of the curriculum
4. Tie up with online course content providers for additional courses and learning material
