Guidelines for candidates shortlisted for written test/interview at IIIT Bangalore

General Guidelines

- Your written test and interview will be held in IIIT Bangalore on the date and approximate time indicated in your test and interview call email. You would get about 30 minutes with the Interview Panel.
- Admission decisions will be based on an objective assessment of your performance in the interview along with the information furnished by you as part of the online application.
- You must report at the Institute at least half-an-hour before the date and time given above and expect to spend at least 6 hours in the IIIT Bangalore campus.
- The on-campus evaluation will be primarily technical aimed at assessing your aptitude, attitude and technical competence for academic research.
- Please be aware that we do not have accommodation available for staying in the campus.
- The institute does not provide TA / DA for attending the interview.

What to Bring (MANDATORY)

- 1. A valid Photo ID.
- 2. Call letter for on-campus evaluation (a printout of the email).
- 3. Resume.
- 4. GATE / GRE scorecards if any.
- 5. Statement of Purpose and Research Preparation.
- 6. Any other documents that may have been missing from your application when you submitted such as accepted publications if any etc.

How to Reach

IIIT Bangalore is located in the heart of Electronics City, right opposite to Infosys Gate 1. You may avail BMTC buses from the city bus terminus (Kempegowda Bus Stand), Bangalore. Both A/C Volvo buses and normal buses ply regularly to Electronics City from different parts of the city. The institute is located about 25 kilometres from the Bangalore City Railway Station and about 55 kilometres from the airport.
