Inauguration of the workshop on Big Data Engineering organized by Prof. Srinath Srinivasa and his lab lined up speakers from inside and outside of IIIT-B. Prof. Sridhar spearheaded the inauguration of ICANN 58 Readout Session.

April was special elsewhere in the world with the announcement of 2016 Turing Award. Sir Tim Berners-Lee is the recipient for his invention of the World Wide Web. He was the Chief Guest (along with former President of India, A. P. J. Abdul Kalam) for the WWW2011 Conference that came to India for the first time, in March 2011. IIIT-B had hosted WWW2011 in Hyderabad. Elsewhere outside the world, on April 26, the spacecraft Cassini,

which is a joint endeavor of NASA, ESA, and Italian Space Agency, entered Saturn and started its grand finale of a series of dives between Saturn and its rings.

Achievements




Balaji Parthasarathy was part of a special "Authors meet Critics" session at the Association of American Geographers (AAG) annual conference in Boston during April 5-9, to discuss his December 2016 book, "The Rise of the Hybrid Domain: Collaborative Governance for Social Innovation", which was coauthored by Yuko Aoyama (http://www.eelgar.com/shop/the-rise-of-the-hybriddomain). The discussion was moderated by Rory Horner (University of Manchester).

The Ph.D. colloquium was held on April 7, where eight papers by our Ph.D. scholars were presented. The papers were selected from different areas through an internal review process. The Open House was conducted on April 8, which was attended by around 75 external students as well as working executives from the IT industry. Dr. Rajendra Kumar Bera gave the keynote speech on the day. In his talk, Dr. Bera emphasized on different aspects of research activities. IIIT-B faculty made domain-wise presentations of their research interests and active projects. The Open Studio was held on April 9, and was inaugurated by the Director Prof. S. Sadagopan. Industry luminaries, investors, founders of start-ups, research heads of industry technology labs, and few faculty members shared their experience and thoughts on how research-led innovation can be lucrative for research students as well as faculty alike. Around 70 entrepreneurs and students attended the

ICANN 58 Readout session was hosted by IIIT-B on April 21. There were 30 attendees in person; 10 present at NIXI hub at New Delhi; and 10-15 joined online from different locations. After the welcome address by Prof. Sadagopan, Director of IIIT-B, Mr. Samiran Gupta, India Head, ICANN presented highlights of the Copenhagen (ICANN 58) meeting of ICANN. This was followed by a presentation on ICANN's Government Advisory Committee (GAC) by Mr. Pradeep Kumar Verma, Scientist, Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology (Meity) from the host location at IIIT-B. Next, Neha Naik, Director, Channel Partnerships, Radix gave an interesting overview of the new generic Top Level Domains (ngTLDs) and the business cases for the same from her location at Mumbai. Brajesh Jain, Member, Numbers Resource Organisation from NICI hub location at New Delhi, gave the status update on numbering resource initiative, especially in the context of forthcoming demand for IPv6. The last readout was by Satish Babu, Chair, Asia-Pacific Regional At-Large Organization (APRALO), who provided a status update on the discussions and initiatives of At-Large community at ICANN 58. The Q&A session that followed after all the above presentations was quite interactive with questions from different participants and answered by the speakers and was well moderated by Prof. V. Sridhar of IIIT-B. Prof. Srinath Srinivasa, Dean of Research & Development, IIIT-B gave concluding remarks, highlighting the research opportunities in the area of Web and Internet policy for the future. Prof. Srinath and his lab, Web Sciences Lab, organized the event.

"Hack for Smarter Cities" hackathon was held during April 22-23 at IIIT-B in partnership with eGovernment Foundation - the organization credited with transforming governance through technology in various states. 125 hackers (25 teams) participated, out of which 17 teams (9 external, 8 IIIT-B) were qualified for presenting their ideas to the panel of judges comprising of Mr. Srikanth Nadhamuni, Managing Trustee, eGov Mr. Viraj Tyagi, CEO, eGov, and Profs. Amit Prakash and Ramesh Sundararaman. The top five teams were selected based on a detailed review of their code and the presentation made to the judges.
