The Institute has embarked on several journeys, some of walking down memory lanes and others, of turning over new leaves, in the month of February. The CCSER Programme kicked off its first continuing education program of Cyber Security Basics on the 18th. Prof. Thangaraju joined as a faculty member on the 23rd.

The theme of journeys pervaded everywhere else in the globe. We are proud of the first of its kind launch of 104 satellites in a single flight of ISRO's PSLV-C37, in its 39th flight, on the 15th. Prof. Mildred Dresselhaus of MIT, popularly known as the Queen of Carbon, sadly passed away on the 20th at the age of 86. Her research in properties of Carbon has essentially pioneered the work in nano science. Her advocacy for gender equity in science will be well-remembered globally for upcoming International Women's Day on March 8. There was a news splash in space science on the 22nd, when several scientists at CalTech discovered seven potentially habitable exoplanets orbiting the star, TRAPPIST-1, using the Spitzer Space Telescope. This is a new record of habitable planets in a single star system, outside of the solar system.


