## From the Director's Desk



The month of July is important for IIIT Bangalore, as our convocation takes place on the first Sunday of every July and we welcome our new batches of students in the second half of the month traditionally. Convocation 2017 was special with a record number (in double digits) of students graduating with Research degrees (Master of Science by Research/Doctor of Philosophy). Professor Indranil Manna, Director, IIT Kanpur, was the Chief Guest for the ceremony, and Dr. Subhash Chandra Khuntia, IAS, Chief Secretary, Government of Karnataka, was the Guest of Honour. Our first batch of students of the Integrated M.Tech. (iMTech), M.Sc Digital Society and Sponsored M.Tech. programs graduated on that day. Newly admitted batch of students in M.Tech. arrived on the campus on July 7. The new batch of

students arrived by the end of the month for all the other degree programs, including the third batch of M.Sc. in Digital Society.

Our new academic block was used formally during the Convocation and is set for classes to begin in August.

India celebrated a success story in technological development in July. The DEMU (Diesel Electric Multiple Unit) train with solar panels on its coaches was launched at the Safdarjung Railway Station on July 14. But July 14 was also a sad day in the Mathematics world as Prof. Maryam Mirzakhani, the only woman to win the prestigious Fields Medal, passed away after a long battle with breast cancer on that day. She was awarded the Fields Medal in 2014 for her work in the Geometry of Riemannian surfaces. May her soul rest in peace.



The group demonstrated a surgical snake device envisioned to be usable as a single port endoscopy probe, an assistive and wearable lower limb device to overcome DVT problems, as well as a programmable Braille reader device. The group demonstrated the devices to Shri Priyank Kharge, Minister for IT/BT, Government of Karnataka, and Shri R V Deshpande, Minister for Large and Medium Industries, Government of Karnataka.
