## **Campus News**

The campus hosted over 25 children from Surabhi Foundation Trust, an orphanage in Bengaluru, to spend the day with the students of IIITB.

The celebrations involved cultural programs by IIITB students as well as the children from Surabhi Foundation Trust. Tree plantation activity was also organized on the campus under HRD ministry's new campaign, "One Student One Tree".

**on IT**, on August 21. The lecture was delivered by Dr. Balaraman Ravindran, Head, Robert Bosch Centre for Data Science and Artificial Intelligence, and Professor of Computer Science and Engineering, IIT Madras. The title of the talk was, "Why the Recent Excitement in Artificial Intelligence?"

"Making Math Count" Hackathon by Gyanome Foundation and IIITB was held during August 19-20. The hackathon engaged six Navodaya teachers from different districts of Karnataka, including a maths communicator, Mr. Gurmeet Singh. Prof. Sujatha Ramadorai introduced the audience to the Gyanome Foundation. Prof. Ramesh Sundararaman then spoke about the collaboration between IIITB and the Foundation. The pressing issues in mathematics education, including lack of content, need for a helping hand for teachers, need of translation of content in vernacular languages and others were discussed. The second day saw discussions on the topic of spreading mathematics across cultures and various ways to convert existing content to vernacular languages, which could also be replicated into short stories.





To help students achieve their entrepreneurial dreams, IIITB has come up with an oncampus E-cell. Inaugurated on August 23, the cell will act as a bridge between the students, staff, research labs, institute's Innovation Centre and alumni, in addition to helping students in spotting business ideas and executing them successfully. With Ecell, students will get to experience the entire process - from developing their startup ideas to prototyping, testing and finally pitching them to investors.





An interactive session was organized by the students (IIITB E-Cell) and startups (IIITB Innovation Center) with Ms. Radha Kizhanattam, Investment Director, Unitus Ventures, on August 27.

IIITB signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with the Phillipine Statistics Authority, the Republic of the Phillippines on August 28. The MoU will drive the adoption of the Modular Open Source Identity Platform (MOSIP) in the implementation of PhilSys, a foundational national ID system for all citizens of the Phillippines and qualified resident aliens.

MOSIP is a global digital public good that countries and other ID issuing organisations can adapt and customize to develop a foundational ID system. It empowers user organisations to remain in control of the process of conceptualization, development, and maintenance of critical digital infrastructure such as national ID systems and

addresses the problems arising out of closed proprietary technologies and consequent vendor lock-in.

The Understanding lays out the framework of cooperation between the signatories on the transfer of code and documentation, transfer of knowledge, support in the adaption of the platform, and support in capacity building of the Philippine Statistics Authority in implementation of PhilSys.

In accordance with its mandate, IIITB will support the Philippine Statistics Authority over the next three years in the creation of an ID system that is inclusive, safe and empowering to individuals.

IIITB hosted "AI Conclave: Voice, Vision, Data Intelligence", jointly with Samsung SRI-B (Bangalore), co-hosted by MINRO, on August 30. Speakers from both Samsung and IIITB gave talks and exchanged ideas for future collaboration. Dr. Vikram Vij, Vice President from SRI-B gave the Key-note talk. Prof. Sadagopan, inaugurated the conclave, and Mr. Tridib Roy Choudhury, the Chief Program Officer, MINRO, welcomed the participants. Prof. Ramasubramanian, IIITB and Dr. Ajit Bopardikar, Samsung coordinated the day-long event.


